Show - Conditions of Entry

- 1. The Show is judged under the standardised guidelines laid down by the Exhibition Poultry Association of NSW Inc. Any person found guilty of any malpractice will be reported to the State Controlling Body.
- 2. The Committee reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry without disclosing the reason.
- 3. All entries are to be the bona fide property of the Exhibitor.
- 4. No fraudulent practice will be allowed. Every exhibitor shall be deemed to be, and will be held, responsible for the condition in which his exhibit appears in the Show pen. Diseased or vermin affected birds will be removed at the discretion of the Chief Steward.
- 5. Leg bands and tags must be removed prior to judging.
- 6. No eggs are to be removed from the pens EXCEPT by the Stewards.
- 7. No bird may be removed from its pen without the permission of the Chief Steward and then only with a Steward in attendance.
- 8. Exhibitors and onlookers are to refrain from talking to or otherwise distracting the Judge & Stewards. Offenders will be removed from the Pavilion.
- 9. Judging sticks are to be used by the JUDGES ONLY.
- 10.Junior Exhibitor classes are restricted to exhibitors under 18 years at the time of the Show. Junior Exhibitors MUST pen their own exhibits. Junior Exhibitors may exhibit in Open Classes.
- 11.Due care is taken, but the Association will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage arising from any cause. All exhibits are entered at the risk of the Exhibitor.
- 12.Birds entered in wrong classes will not be judged.
- 13.If 5 or more of the same variety or colour are entered a new class will be made. Please state variety or colour on the entry form.
- 14. Birds in Breeding Pair classes will not be eligible for major awards.
- 15.Judges who officiate are not to exhibit birds in the breed classes they are judging.
- 16. Judging is by the Australian Poultry Standards.
